To get 100' past the boulevard would be 580' from the last manhole. VDOT has stated that they will require a jack-n-bore across the boulevard. This is very cost prohibitive (additional \$25,000) from conventional installation.

To lay conventially with pavement patch across the boulevard - \$120,000. This includes full stone backfill underneath the road area.

To jack-n-bore under the road and conventially lay the remaining - \$145,000.

Both of the above includes design (\$4800), 2 manholes, 18" gravity sewer, wellpointing, and reclamation. Jack-n-Bore option requires ductile iron pipe through the casing.

Let me know if you have questions. I think it would be worth you approaching Jerry Kee about open cutting the road.

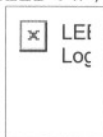

VDOT has agreed to the open cut however, they indicated they will require adequate milling and paving of the cut to assure smooth travel through the intersection.
