

2. HIGHWAY MATTERS**A. AMENDMENT OF SIX-YEAR PLAN**

With the reduced scope of work on Route 671 that the Board approved last month, excess funding that was designated for the project will soon become available for other projects. For some time now, I've been discussing with Mr. Kee the possibility of transferring any excess funds to improvements that will be required on Rose Valley Road in order to facilitate development of the new industrial park. The most recent budget estimate that I have for Rose Valley Road improvements is \$1.55 million. I've asked Mr. Kee to quantify the amount of state funding that may now be available for the project and prepare the requisite resolution to reallocate the funding. At this writing, I'm awaiting the resolution but hope that Mr. Kee will have it available prior to Monday's meeting.

MOTION REQUIRED: If the Board is so inclined, a motion is required to adopt a resolution prioritizing improvements on Rose Valley Road and reallocating the excess funding derived from the reduced scope of work on Route 671.
