

Land Use Program

To enroll in the Land Use Program, the landowner must:

- Submit an application for each parcel of land to the Commissioner of the Revenue
 - Before the application is brought to the Commissioner of the Revenue, the applicant must:
 - Fill out Map #, Acreage, Name, Address, and Telephone Number - The map number, acreage, and owner's name can be obtained from your most recent tax bill.
 - Have zoning department fill out and sign the area in the top right corner of the application (in the Office Use Only section). If the property is not zoned agricultural, the application will not be accepted.
 - Have treasurer's office fill out and sign the area in the top right corner of the application (in the Office Use Only section). If there are delinquent taxes on the parcel, the application will not be accepted.
 - Have all parties owning an interest in the parcel sign application
 - One application can be used for multiple parcels if the parcels are currently joined on one account for billing purposes; however the fee is based on number of parcels, not number of applications.
 - Unless we have entered a due date on your application, the application is due by November 1st of the preceding year for which you are applying for the program.
- Remit payment of **\$20 per parcel** to the treasurer's office

To remain in the land use program, the landowner must:

- Submit a new application whenever the use or acreage of previously approved land changes
- Keep taxes current
- Revalidate on the sixth year following the original application
