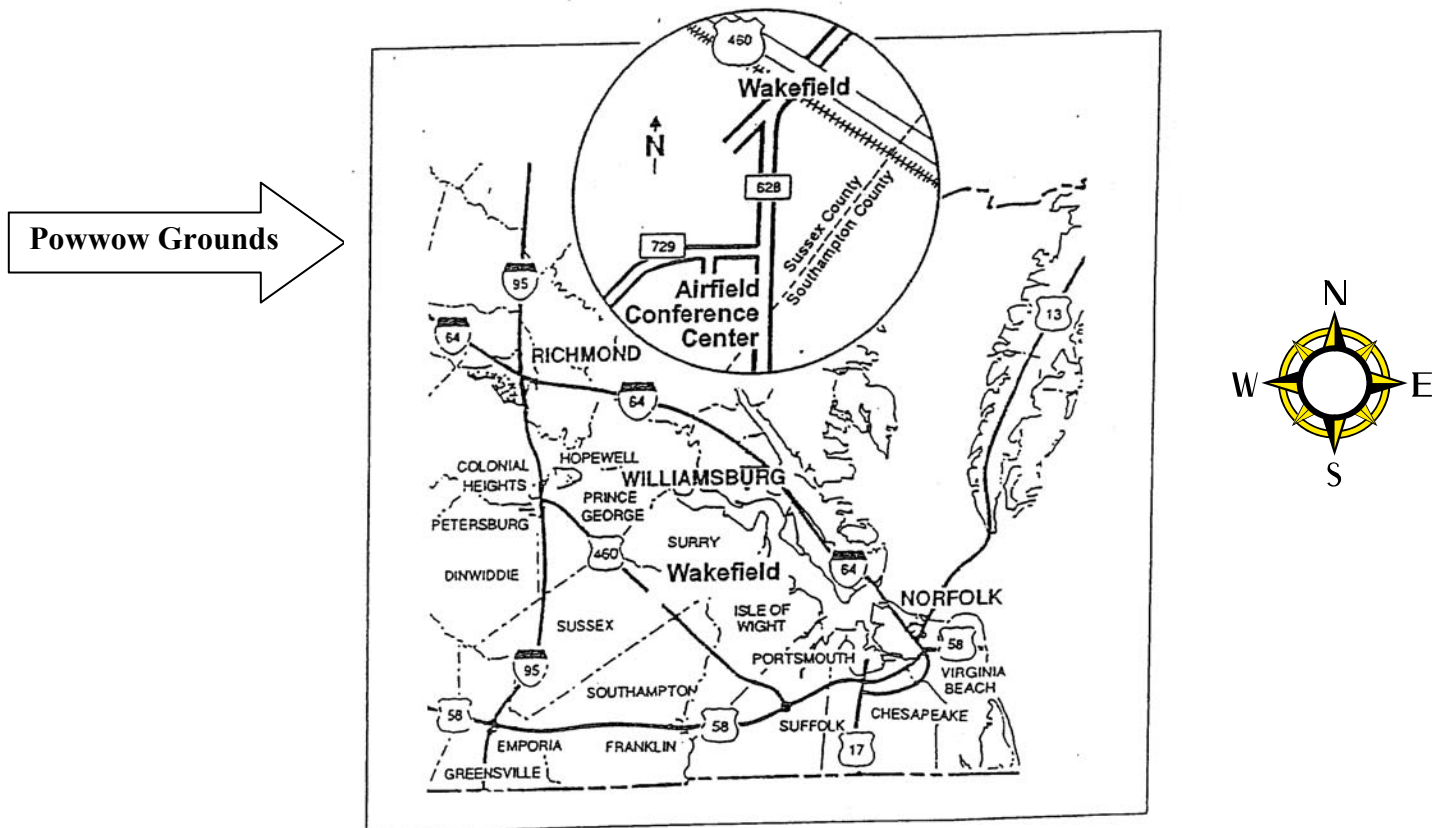

## DIRECTIONS TO POWWOW

**6.5 MILES SOUTH ON ROUTE 628 FROM WAKEFIELD, VIRGINIA**



**From Richmond, VA – Take I 95 or I 295 South to Petersburg – take Hwy 460 east towards Suffolk, VA. In Wakefield turn right at the stoplight onto Route 628. Follow road for 5 ½ miles. Turn right on Turkey Pen Road (Route 729) and go 1 mile. Turn left at gate (Airfield Road) and follow Powwow Signs.**

**From Norfolk, VA – Take 264 or 64 West to Bowers Hill and pick up Route 58 West towards Suffolk. Follow Route 58 until you see exit to 460 West. Turn on 460 West to Wakefield. At stoplight in Wakefield turn left onto Route 628. Follow road for 5 ½ miles. Turn right on Turkey Pen Road (Route 729) and go 1 mile. Turn left at gate (Airfield Road) and follow Powwow Signs.**

**From Williamsburg, VA – Take Route 31 (Jamestown Road) to the ferry. Off the ferry continue on Route 31 to Wakefield at stoplight, continue straight. This will put you on Route 628. Follow Route 628 for 5 ½ miles. Turn right on Turkey Pen Road (Route 729) and go 1 mile. Turn left at gate (Airfield Road) and follow Powwow Signs.**

**From Courtland / Franklin, VA - Take Route 35 heading towards Petersburg, 3 ½ miles outside of Courtland, VA, turn right into Route 628 to Wakefield. Go approx. 12 miles. You'll come to Airfield Lake spillway (leave Southampton County – enter Sussex County) go 1 mile and turn left onto on Turkey Pen Road (Route 729) and go 1 mile. Turn left at gate (Airfield Road) and follow Powwow Signs.**
