

6. APPOINTMENTS**A. BOARD OF BUILDING CODE APPEALS**

As you may recall from last month, Mr. E.P. Kea, Jr.'s term on the Board of Building Code Appeals recently expired. Supervisor West has indicated that Mr. Kea is willing to serve another term, which will run through September 2013.

MOTION REQUIRED: A motion is required to fill the appointments to the Board of Building Code Appeals.

B. FRANKLIN-SOUTHAMPTON FUTURES, INC.

As you may recall, the bylaws for Franklin-Southampton Futures, Inc. provide that the Board will consist of nine (9) members, two of which shall have been nominated by the Board of Supervisors of Southampton County, two by the Franklin City Council, two by the local foundations (Franklin-Southampton Charities and The Camp Foundation), one by the Chamber of Commerce and one by the full membership of Franklin-Southampton Futures, Inc. The ninth member of the Board is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Franklin-Southampton Economic Development Authority. No elected official or city manager or county administrator or school superintendent of Southampton County or the City of Franklin is permitted to serve on the Board of Directors.

Jane Riddick Fries, one of the original Southampton County nominees, recently announced that she is unable to serve another term, due to professional and family commitments. It is my understanding that Supervisor West has spoken with and intends to nominate Mrs. Ashlyn Scarborough to succeed Mrs. Fries.

MOTION REQUIRED: If the Board is so inclined, a motion is required to nominate Mrs. Ashlyn Scarborough to succeed Mrs. Jane Riddick Fries on the Board of Directors for Franklin-Southampton Futures, Inc.
