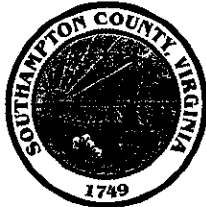

RE: State Scenic River Designation - Blackwater River

Dear Ms. Crump:

In their December 2008 regular session, by unanimous voice vote, the Board of Supervisors directed me to officially request the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation to study a segment of the Blackwater River beginning at the Southampton/Surry County line and ending where it conjoins the Nottoway River to determine if it qualifies for designation as a State Scenic River pursuant to *The Virginia Scenic Rivers Act of 1970*.

It is my understanding that the County of Isle of Wight has already expressed its support for the study and by copy of this letter, I'm requesting the Cities of Franklin and Suffolk to endorse the study as interested and affected parties.

We are hopeful that the report may be prepared and presented to the respective local governing bodies in sufficient time to obtain citizen input and request the introduction of pertinent legislation during the 2010 legislative session of the Virginia General Assembly.

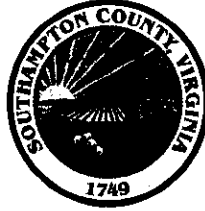

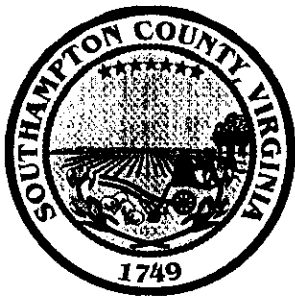



**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF

OF AN ETHANOL PLANT IN NORTHAMPTON COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

WHEREAS, East Coast Ethanol, LLC recently announced plans to construct four 110 million gallon per year ethanol plants, including one near Seaboard, a town in Northampton County, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the proposed site in Northampton County, North Carolina is located within ten miles of Southampton County, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the proposed ethanol plant is expected to provide a degree of risk reduction and price support for local corn producers, creating demand for 30 million bushels of corn per year and adding 30 to 50 cents per bushel to the price of corn; and

WHEREAS, East Coast Ethanol, LLC has announced that the plant in Northampton County, North Carolina will seek to purchase as much corn locally as possible, augmenting that with the addition of corn brought in by rail from the Midwest United States; and

WHEREAS, in addition to ethanol production, the proposed plant is expected to co-produce 353,000 tons annually of distilled dried grains, a high-protein, high-energy animal feed supplement which will be marketed to the dairy, beef and poultry industries; and

WHEREAS, it is generally agreed that it is in our nation's best interest to reduce global dependency on oil from unstable regions of the world; and

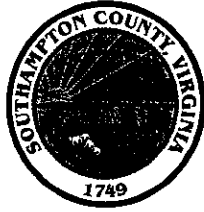
WHEREAS, the federal government has recognized the importance of ethanol, making increased ethanol production a cornerstone of the Renewable Fuels, Consumer Protection, and Energy Efficiency Act of 2007.

RE: Bulk Water Purchase Agreement

Dear Mrs. Fleming:

Thank you and Mr. Williams for taking the time to meet with me last month to discuss the possibility of a discounted bulk water agreement between Southampton County and the City of Franklin. Based on our discussion, it's my understanding that you would like to present this matter to the Franklin City Council for their conceptual consideration in advance of any substantive discussion, or negotiation of potential terms and provisions. The purpose of my letter is to frame the issue and articulate the rationale for our request.

The agreement that we envision would apply exclusively to locations where water is delivered in bulk from the City to Southampton County, measured by a master meter, and subsequently conveyed to county consumers through a distribution network of pipes owned and maintained by Southampton County. At this writing, there are only two such locations — one along General Thomas Highway just west of U.S. Route 58 (I.P.'s Converting Innovation Center is presently the sole connection), and the other at Delaware Road and Camp Parkway (presently, Riverdale Elementary School is the sole connection). At both of these locations, there is a clear line of demarcation between city and county systems at the master meter and Southampton County is currently billed at the retail rate for all water passing through the master meter.

We believe that there are compelling reasons for the City to favorably consider a discounted bulk rate. As you know, retail water rates are imposed upon system users to sufficiently recover the City's cost of operating and maintaining the system, servicing the associated debt, and providing adequate cash reserves for future capital improvements to the system. However, in the two locations described above, the City has incurred no additional debt, nor is it responsible for any ongoing maintenance or future capital improvements down gradient of the master meter.

In the case of the Delaware Road/Camp Parkway area, the waterline was constructed by a private developer, at no expense to the City, the cost of which will presumably be recovered by the developer from purchasers of residential building lots in

the future subdivision. Also keep in mind that the City is not responsible for any future expenses associated with the proposed development — no taps to install, no leaks to fix, no valves or hydrants to repair, no meters to read, no customer accounts to maintain, no delinquencies to collect, and no complaints (inadequate pressure, billing discrepancies, water quality, etc.) to resolve. And the same is generally true for the General Thomas Highway corridor. These expenses will be borne by Southampton County, and subsequently recovered from its monthly charge to system users.

In light of these factors, the City's direct cost per gallon in delivering water to a master meter is substantially lower than its cost per gallon in delivering water directly to retail consumers. If the City charges Southampton County full retail price for a bulk water purchase, and the County subsequently adds reasonable and sufficient charges to cover its operational and maintenance expenses, future customers in Southampton County are unfairly burdened. Our sole objective, and the rationale for this request, is simply to negotiate a bulk water rate that will allow us to charge our system customers rates that are comparable with other Southampton County residents directly connected to the City of Franklin's water system.

Finally, please note that any such agreement *would not apply* to service areas in Southampton County in which the City of Franklin maintains ownership and control of the distribution system and bills county consumers directly, such as Cypress Manor, Regency Estates and Brandywine, if and when it develops. It would only apply to master-metered locations.

Thank you in advance for sharing this request with the City Council as you deem appropriate. If you have questions, or would like me to be available to meet with City Council representatives, please advise.

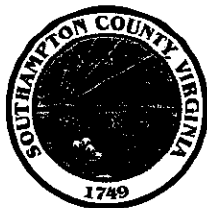
