

15. CLOSED MEETING

It is necessary for this Board to now conduct a closed meeting in accordance with the provisions set out in the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, for the following purposes:

- 1) Section 2.2-3711 (A) (5) Discussion concerning prospective industries where no previous announcement has been made of the business' or industry's interest in locating its facilities in the community.
- 2) Section 2.2-3711 (A) (7) Consultation with legal counsel and briefings by staff members related to actual litigation (Anthony Scodes v. Southampton County Board of Supervisors and Southampton County) where such briefing in an open session would adversely affect the litigating posture of the public body;
- 3) Section 2.2-3711 (A) (7) Consultation with legal counsel and briefings by staff members related to actual litigation (Cheverly, Ltd. v. Robert L. Barnett) where such briefing in an open session would adversely affect the litigating posture of the public body; and
- 4) Section 2.2-3711 (A) (29) Discussion of a public contract where discussion of the terms and scope of such contract in open session would adversely affect the negotiating strategy of the governing body.

MOTION REQUIRED: A motion is required to convene a closed meeting for the purposes described above.
