

5. APPOINTMENTS

A. PAUL D. CAMP COMMUNITY COLLEGE LOCAL BOARD

As you recall from last month, Ms. Alice Parker recently resigned from her position on the local board in order to avoid a conflict of interest – her son, Travis, was hired by PDCCC to serve as its Director of the Upward Bound Program.
