The following are codes for the types of recycle bins available at designated sites:

M=Motor Oil (used); L=Limb box; R=Residential Recycling

Residential Recyclable Items include:

Newspapers, loose leaf paper, magazines, junk mail and envelopes, telephone books, aluminum cans (no lids), glass bottles and jars (clear, brown, and green-no caps or lids), plastic bottles and tubs (must rinse before recycling and no caps or lids), steel/tin cans (no lids), cardboard, cereal boxes (do not include plastic liner), food packaging boxes (do not include plastic inserts), paper towel cardboard rolls

Items that are NOT RECYCLABLE:

Pizza boxes from restaurants, plastic bags, frozen food entrée containers, pie plates and foil that have food on them, light bulbs, broken glass, paint cans, clothing, Hazardous materials (pesticides, fertilizers, etc.)
